




 Aluminum	Beverage Cans, Aluminum Foil, Pie Plates Rinsed Clean and Flattened	Folding Chair Frames or other large items can be taken to a local salvage yard
 Cardboard & Chipboard	Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Dry Food Boxes (cake, cereal, cracker) Shoe Boxes, Bar Soap or Detergent Boxes, Towel or Tissue Rolls, Pizza Boxes,	No Foam Packing Material, No Wax or Plastic Liners
 Glass	Glass Food and Beverage Containers (clear, brown, green or blue) Please Remove Lids. Plastic Lids are recyclable	No Light Bulbs, Window Glass, Mirror Glass, Ceramics or Pottery
 Magazines	All Magazines, Catalogs, Telephone Books, Hardback or Paperback Books	No Wet, Damp, or Musty Paper Remove Plastic Wrappers
 Metal Cans	Steel or Tin Cans (rinse clean, remove ends, and flatten if possible)	No Other Metals (These can be taken to an area salvage yard)
 Newspaper	Newspaper and All Inserts Junk mail, paper grocery bags, file folders	Bundle together in Paper or Plastic Bags
 Paper	Computer and Writing Paper, Envelopes (separate White paper) (if shredded, bring in separate container)	No Facial or Toilet Tissue, Paper Towels or Plates, Napkins, Diapers, Pet Food Bags with plastic liners,
 Plastics	Check the number in the triangle on the bottom of the container, We accept numbers 1, 2, 4, and 7 so long as containers have a screw-on type opening. LIDS can now be recycled, but PLEASE REMOVE THEM. Plastic Bags, Bubble Wrap, Shrink Wrap	We CANNOT accept numbers 3, 5 or 6 Please rinse containers that contained food. No Hazardous Chemical or Automotive Oil Containers, No Styrofoam, No fast food cups or containers No flat-lid or hinged containers such as for butter, yogurt, ice cream, frozen dinners or produce

Tuesday and Thursdays from 12:30 to 4 p.m.

- Please do not come in on Mon., Wed., or Fri. as businesses and institutions bring in large trucks on those days and we cannot accommodate private vehicles.
- PLEASE do not leave items outside the building when we are closed.
- Your support of your area recycling program is appreciated. *We must ask you to adhere to the recycling guidelines.* These have recently changed. Please take time to read the chart on the back of the page.
- Don't hesitate to ask us any questions you may have.
- Please do not bring in materials that are not on our list of approved recyclables. Bringing in these items raises our costs due to disposal fees.
- Thank you for your understanding and continued support. Your participation & cooperation is what makes our area-wide efforts to REDUCE, REUSE, AND RECYCLE successful.
- Consider buying "Recycled." If there is a demand for products manufactured with recycled content your efforts to "close the loop" can make a difference.
